Introduction

This report summarizes the results of GW Micro's analysis of the accessibility and usability of Accomplish CashManager 2011 with Window-Eyes 7.5.2. Prior to testing the application and conducting the audit, the Window-Eyes CashManager app was installed. The Window-Eyes CashManager app was developed by GW Micro pro bono to enhance the accessibility of CashManager with Window-Eyes and can be downloaded for free using App Get or from App Central (www.gwmicro.com/ac).

GW Micro's testing methodology involved completing a series of tasks in CashManager 2011 that were identified by Accomplish as essential to the core functionality of the application. These tasks included: software installation, registering the software, entering bank transactions, manual bank account reconciliation, bank statement importing, creating reports, creating graphs, invoicing, invoicing reports, and contact management. These tasks and instructions for completing them are documented in the CashManager tutorial guide provided by Accomplish Global.

The report documents every major interface that was encountered as each task was completed in CashManager. For each interface, five pieces of information were compiled. The title of the dialog or window, a screen shot of the interface, the steps taken to reach the interface, notes about the current accessibility and usability of the interface with Window-Eyes and finally notes about the recommended steps that could be taken to improve the accessibility and usability of the interface with Window-Eyes.


At the end of the report, the results of the audit will be summarized in an effort to explain the current overall level of accessibility and usability of CashManager with Window-Eyes as well as to discuss recommended enhancements that could be added to make CashManager more accessible and user friendly with Window-Eyes.

Comments From Accomplish:

We have taken into account everything in this audit, and have made some changes to our 2012 release. We have added a comment to each section summarizing the changes, or comments on what we are doing about the recommendations made by GW Micro.

The CashManager software installation was initiated by running the CMW16Setup.EXE setup file that was provided to GW Micro by Accomplish Global. The following interfaces cover the CashManager installation process.



- The accelerator keys for the combo boxes are not spoken by Window-Eyes.
- The account balance read-only edit box's value can only be read via the mouse
- Standard keyboard navigation techniques can be used to interact with the

dialog's controls.

Notes about preferred navigation and Window-Eyes output (expected behavior):

- The accelerator keys for the combo boxes should be spoken by Window-Eyes when the control gains focus (e.g. Bank account, a).
- It would also be helpful for the column headers to be spoken automatically prior to the value being spoken (e.g. Deposit, 17555.77).
- Keyboard navigation should also be added for the Account balance read-only
 edit box so a user could easily Tab into the control to obtain the value.
- Please consider making this interface a standard dialog as it would make it easier to complete various tasks including reading the title bar with the Title/Status of Window hotkey, maximizing the window and reading the contents of the dialog with the Read Active Window hotkey.





- The Opening balance values can only be read via the mouse.
- The accelerator keys are not spoken for the combo boxes or edit boxes but are spoken for buttons.
- Standard keyboard navigation techniques can be used to interact with the dialog's controls.
- The static text and title bar can be read using the mouse or the Read Active Window hotkey but when doing so the dialog is only read after the main Cash Manager window.

Notes about preferred navigation and Window-Eyes output (expected behavior):

• The accelerator keys for the combo box and edit boxes should be spoken by

- Window-Eyes when the control gains focus (e.g. Select Bank Account, k).
- Keyboard navigation should also be added for the Opening balance data so a
 user could easily Tab into the control to obtain the value.
- If possible, please design the dialog so that Window-Eyes automatically speaks all of the contents including title bar, static text and controls or ensure the dialog can be read with the Read Active Window hotkey without hearing information from the main CashManager window.



- Window-Eyes speaks the selected item's value from each column found in the transaction list view accurately but the column headers are not read.
- The default width of the date field is too narrow to display the second digit of the year which prevents Window-Eyes from speaking the full date (e.g. 12/14/0 instead of 12/12/09).
- Window-Eyes speaks each control's value and label accurately when you navigate using the Tab key.
- The accelerator key for the Sort transaction by combo box is not spoken by Window-Eyes.

- Standard keyboard navigation techniques can be used to interact with the dialog's controls.
- The static text and title bar can be read using the mouse or the Read Active Window hotkey but when doing so the dialog is only read after the main Cash Manager window.

Notes about preferred navigation and Window-Eyes output (expected behavior):

- It would be helpful if the accelerator keys were announced for all controls.
- It would also be helpful for the column headers to be spoken automatically prior to the value being spoken (e.g. Deposit, 875.00).
- It is also recommended to increase the default width of the date column to ensure the entire date is displayed and read by Window-Eyes.

- The accelerator keys are not spoken for the combo boxes or edit boxes but are spoken for the check boxes, buttons and the radio buttons found in the Report Options section of the dialog.
- Standard keyboard navigation can be used to navigate and interact with the controls found in the dialog.
- The Sort order for report combo box is classified as an edit box by Window-Eyes.
- There is no spoken indication that the edit boxes include a browse/search button that can be accessed by pressing F2.

 The static text and title bar can be read using the mouse or the Read Active Window hotkey but when doing so the dialog is only read after the main Cash Manager window.


Notes about preferred navigation and Window-Eyes output (expected behavior):

- The accelerator keys for all controls should be spoken automatically.
- It might also be helpful to make each group of report type radio buttons a separate control so you can navigate among them using TAB or accelerator keys.
- The Sort order for report combo box should be correctly classified so Window-Eyes does not say edit box.
- If possible, please design the dialog so that Window-Eyes automatically speaks all of the contents including title bar, static text and controls or ensure the dialog can be read with the Read Active Window hotkey without hearing information from the main CashManager window.





- 1. Activate the Notes button or press Alt-O from the Contact Management dialog Notes about accessibility or usability issues (current behavior):
 - Upon initial focus, Window-Eyes speaks the title of the dialog followed by the Date edit box's field label and value.
 - The accelerator keys are not announced for the edit boxes or combo boxes but are spoken for the check box control and buttons.



- You can use the up/down arrow keys to navigate the list view and Window-Eyes will read the data displayed in the currently selected record.
- The column headers are not announced and can only be read with the mouse.
- Standard keyboard navigation can be used to interact with the dialog's controls.

Summary

Accomplish Ltd. has made a conscious effort to create an accessible product and ensure that individuals using a screen reader can accomplish almost every task in the CashManager application quickly, efficiently and intuitively. This is clearly demonstrated in the application. Specifically, the software developers put forth extra effort to create equivalent keyboard navigation techniques for almost all mouse driven activities including program navigation and data input.

While the Window-Eyes screen reader was able to provide access to the majority of CashManager 2011's menus, dialogs and controls out-of-the box, there were several areas of the application where special customization was required to make certain list view controls speak correctly. These accessibility enhancements were developed pro bono by GW Micro and incorporated into the Window-Eyes CashManager app. To benefit from these accessibility enhancements, users of Window-Eyes should always install the Window-Eyes CashManager app prior to using Cash Manager.

Here are several specific items that were identified in the application as positive design decisions or helpful enhancements to the level of accessibility and usability of CashManager with Window-Eyes:

- Every clickable button found in the main CashManager user interface has a corresponding menu entry that can be easily accessed using standard keyboard navigation.
- Virtually every control including combo boxes, edit boxes, check boxes and buttons had a corresponding accelerator key which allows for efficient keyboard interaction.

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- Essential commands in dialogs are almost always associated with a well labeled button that can be easily accessed using standard keyboard navigation or accelerator keys.
- The multitude of reports, graphs and charts that can be generated by CashManager can all be saved as PDF files or Excel spreadsheets. Allowing screen reader users to access data in these alternative formats will make the process of evaluating the data much more user friendly as compared to trying to read the information from a print out or from the CashManager interface. Providing users with a list of data points for charts and graphs is also a great design idea that can make accessing the data much more efficient.
- In several list view controls, it is necessary to "Cheque" a record in order to perform a certain action upon it. This type of process is usually designed to be accomplished with the mouse pointer making it very difficult to accomplish as a screen reader user. In CashManager, a simple keyboard alternative of pressing the Spacebar on a selected item is always provided to accomplish this task.

While the application for the most part is fully accessible, there are areas in CashManager that could be enhanced to make the program more accessible, userfriendly and simpler to use especially for novice screen reader users. Below is a listing of several accessibility and usability issues that were found throughout the CashManager application during the Window-Eyes accessibility audit.

- Several of the installation dialogs exhibited a focus/activation issue. If the user moves focus away from the dialog and then attempts to return by pressing Alt-Tab, you are unable to interact with the dialog from the keyboard. The only way to give focus back to the window is to use the mouse and click on the window.
- One significant design issue that was identified throughout the application relates to a large number of interfaces in CashManager that are MDI child windows. Using a MDI child window instead of a standard dialog presents several usability issues:
 - o First, it is much more difficult to efficiently read the title and contents of a MDI child window compared to a standard dialog. For example, when issuing the Read Active Window hotkey on a MDI window, instead of just hearing the content of the MDI child, you first have to hear all of the content found in the MDI child's parent window (e.g. the main CashManager application window).
 - o This design also prevents the user from being able to read the title of the MDI child window using the Read Title hotkey.
 - Lastly, you cannot maximize the MDI child window using standard keyboard techniques (e.g. Alt-Space, X) from a system menu. Instead

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the only way to maximize the window is to use the mouse to click on the Maximize button. Maximizing MDI child windows in several cases would expand the column width of list views allowing certain data elements to be fully displayed resulting in Window-Eyes reading the selected list view item correctly.

- Another issue that was present in the majority of interfaces is that accelerator keys for edit boxes, combo boxes and list views were not spoken by Window-Eyes when the control gained focus. Therefore, a Window-Eyes user would not be notified that the accelerator key was available for a particular control when navigating through the dialog with standard keyboard navigation techniques.
- When navigating through the list views in CashManager, the column headers are not announced prior to speaking the data. This prevents the user from getting the full context of the data they hear when listening to the data found in the selected item.
- There were several read-only edit boxes that were not included in the tab order and could not be accessed via standard keyboard navigation techniques. The only way to navigate to the field or access the data was to use its associated accelerator key (if one existed for the specific control) or the mouse. This is a usability issue and makes finding and accessing the read-only edit box's data much more difficult.
- There are several edit boxes that offer auto completed text/suggestions while typing. The suggested text that is displayed is not spoken by Window-Eyes.
- There were several edit boxes that offer a browse button that could be activated with the mouse or by pressing F2. There is no discernible way to deduce when an edit box has a corresponding browse button.
- There were several list boxes where Window-Eyes was not able to read the focused item when navigating the list with arrow keys or when selecting the item by pressing Spacebar.

The accessibility and usability issues summarized in this report could most likely be resolved by making changes to the underlying design of the CashManager application, developing additional capabilities in Window-Eyes through scripting (e.g. Window-Eyes CashManager app) or through a combination of the two. It is always ideal for screen reader users when changes can be made by the application developer so the user's application and screen reader work together and provide complete access "out-of-the-box". With that being said, GW Micro would be happy to further assist Accomplish Ltd. with improving the accessibility and usability of CashManager through the use of Window-Eyes scripting.
